Mr. Benz,

I have received your fax entitled, “Your Non-responsive Response to 2015-07-23 FOIA Request.” Based upon your responses, your request is still too vague to begin to search the public record for “Best Geo-technical Seismic Practices and Industry Standards” on town property or any other property. A Freedom of Information Act request requires that the requested records be reasonably described. This request does not meet this standard and I am not able to help you at this time. Of course you are welcome to review files at Town Hall or review minutes, agendas, resolutions, etc. at [http://skykomish.org/Agendas\\_Minutes.html](http://skykomish.org/Agendas_Minutes.html).

Because you state that you are requesting information on “all Town of Skykomish public lands, properties and parcels remediated as part of BNSF’s Railway’s environmental cleanup effort,” and because the town was involved in the same manner as private land owners throughout the remediation between BNSF and the Department of Ecology, the town may not have the information you are seeking. Instead, you may wish to seek information regarding “geo-technical” practices or compliance from the Department of Ecology, either on their website or document repository in Bellevue. I hope this helps. This completes this record request.
